### **TRAIL**


If you start at the north end of the trail, park at the Lincoln Children's Zoo, by the Hamann Rose Garden. You'll have to walk north down the ramp to the intersection of the Rock Island and Billy Wolff trails. This is where we started for this guide.



Coming up the hill you'll see this sign point you to stay on Rock Island.



The trail approaches Highway 2, where it intersects with the Boosalis Trail. The bottom photo is at the north end of the bridge that takes you over Highway 2.



Cross over Highway 2, then 27th street, on these elevated bridges



The trail crosses Old Cheney Rd. – and intersects the Old Cheney Trail – here just east of 14th Street. As you approach Densmore Park and the Cooper YMCA you'll see the GPTN Connector Bridge. If you have time for a detour follow the path to the bridge for a great view.



The trail ends at 14th & Pine Lake Rd., right outside of Lincoln Southwest High School.
